

69th Annual Give - A - Gift Program

The SCMA Alliance's long running and beloved gift program is turning 69 years old this December. The Alliance provides gifts to Sonoma County youth in the foster care system. The Give - A - Gift committee works with Sonoma County Department of Health Services Family, Youth and Children Division. Last year, 500 gifts (including 35 bicycles and helmets) were distributed. Gifts are tailored to the children and teens based on wish lists provided to the Alliance by a team of social workers. Many of our members have donated, chaired, and served on the committee for decades!

In 2007, the Give - A - Gift Program was expanded to address the needs of young adults recently emancipated from the foster system who want to attend college. These young people often lack resources and face many barriers when it comes to pursuing a degree. The Give-A-Gift committee decided to remove one educational barrier, the lack of a personal laptop computer. The Alliance is committed to improving retention and success rates for foster youth attending college. Community partners that help the Alliance in these efforts include Best Buy, Microsoft, and Mike's Bikes.
